

- 4. Using a writing or drawing prompt to get your creative thoughts flowing more easily.

- 5. Thinking, looking, or listening outside of the box to see new ideas and opinions.
- 6. Asking others about what inspires them and looking for the hidden beauty in those things.
- 7. Taking a class in something you've never done before or a language you want to learn.
- 8. Traveling to a place you've never been to see the culture and beauty there.

When you teach someone how to locate ideas on their own, they'll possess that skill all their life. Then they can find their own excitement wherever they are: at work, home, or on the go. It's a simple strategy that's great for the creative type, or for anyone who feels stuck in a rut.

Open Your Eyes to Inspiration
